



Explore Your Future In School

OVERVIEW

The Explore Your Future – In School program involves ACU staff and students visiting your school to deliver a range of workshops and hands-on educational activities to students. The program is designed to support their study aspirations and increase awareness of higher education.

EXAMPLE WORKSHOPS INCLUDE

Introduction to paramedicine

- Students can look at what occurs after a car accident to stabilise the spine, relieve pain, and the overall procedure for an emergency response.
- Our paramedicine students explain the role of an emergency responder, share stories about their experiences, and discuss options for paramedicine careers.

Introduction to sport and exercise science

- Students look at career paths in the sports industry including plyometrics and strength training, as well as recovery and rehabilitation.

Introduction to nursing

- Students find out what studying health sciences is all about. They will undertake fun hygiene practicals, find their own heartbeat, and look at possible careers.

Introduction to occupational therapy

- Students find out what it's like to study this growing field. They will learn what occupational therapists do by participating in a range of fun and competitive activities.

WHAT WE REQUIRE

- Access to multiple classrooms or zones to deliver the workshops.
- Year 9 or 10 student groups.
- 1-2 hours for program delivery.
