Terms of Reference:

The Internationalisation Committee give advices to Academic Board on the internationalisation of the University. Specifically the Committee addresses:

1. development of the internationalisation thematic plan, linked to the University Strategic Plan, to set and coordinate strategic direction, and ongoing review of progress against milestones;
2. coordination of Faculty and Directorate internationalisation implementation and operational plans;
3. recommendations regarding the roles of and responsibilities for academic and administrative units in matters relating to internationalisation; and
4. management and reporting of quality assurance in relation to international programs and activities for onshore and offshore international students.

Review: The Committee reviews its procedures as it deems necessary and recommends accordingly to Academic Board.

Definition of Internationalisation: The process of integrating an international intercultural or global dimension into the purpose, functions or delivery of education both onshore and offshore ¹
