<b>Location</b> <i>Lund, Sweden</i> 
<b>Campus Description</b> <p>The campus reflects the University's history, with magnificent buildings separated by cobbled streets and green spaces, but also its vision for the future with, for example, one of Sweden's largest science parks located close to the campus and the planned MAX IV facility and ESS European spallation source.</p>

<b>What is a full time study load?</b> 30 ECTS = 40 ACU credit points (the equivalent of 1 full time semester) ECTS = European Credit Transfer System
<b>Accommodation</b> <p>The housing situation in Lund is somewhat strained as Lund University is a large university in a small city. Sometimes it can be easier, if not ideal, to find housing in the towns surrounding Lund. Commuting is usually very efficient.</p>
<b>Fees/Cost of living</b> <p>The Swedish currency is the krona, abbreviated as SEK. A typical Swedish student budget is SEK 7 800/month (approximately USD 1140 or EUR 866) covering food, housing, clothing, books/materials and leisure time. Students who rent accommodation from the International Housing Office can expect typical rents to range from SEK 2 700 – 4 500 per month, depending on the specific accommodation they are offered.</p>

### Accommodation

Malmö University does not own student dormitories and does not normally organize accommodation for students. However, Malmö University cooperates with two of the larger rental agencies in Malmö to arrange accommodation for certain students stated below. University has a guarantee for our tuition students but cannot guarantee accommodation for all applying exchange students.

To be eligible for housing provided through the university:

- You pay tuition fees for a full-time course/programme at Malmö University.
- You are an exchange student studying in Malmö through an exchange agreement with your home university.
- You are a visiting staff/teacher for a short-term period.

<p><b>Campus Description</b>  Established in 1977, the university has expanded rapidly and currently comprises six departments that offer approximately 50 degree programmes and 800 elective courses.</p> <p>There are approximately 12,000 registered students at the University of Gävle. Half of these students come from the surrounding region; the other half come from other parts of Sweden. Slightly over 50% of the students are female, and the number of students with ethnic backgrounds other than Swedish is increasing each year.</p>
