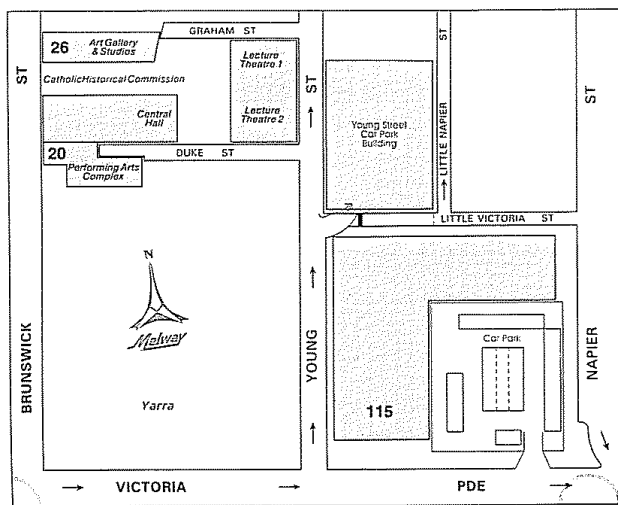


## Directions to Australian Catholic University
