Exchange Students do not need to submit a housing deposit. After final program acceptance by CUA, completed housing applications will be forwarded to Housing Services for processing.

On-campus housing at CUA is highly desired and space is limited. Although campus housing is not guaranteed for Exchange Students, early application to the program is encouraged to facilitate consideration for available housing. Generally, Exchange Students will receive confirmation of their Fall housing assignment by late-July and for the Spring semester by mid-December. For those students planning to be at CUA for both Fall and Spring semesters, please note that housing is not available during Christmas Break as the residence halls are closed.

Students should check their CUA student e-mail to receive updates on their housing assignment before their arrival. The dates the residence halls open and close are posted on the [Housing Services website](#).

Exchange Students with significant international travel itineraries may request to arrive 1-2 days earlier or remain a day later. Generally, requests to arrive any earlier or stay any later will not be approved.

The cost of housing is the responsibility of the visiting student, and will be charged to the CUA student account. For your convenience Housing Services sponsors several [Move-in Services](#) including the sale of XL twin sheets (all mattress at CUA are twin XL). International students that choose to purchase these linens may have them mailed to Housing Services; Housing Services will then deliver them to your room. Campus Description

The 78-acre St. Paul campus consists of the original 45-acre campus, five acres of adjacent properties and 28 acres of the Saint Paul Seminary campus (informally referred to as the "south" campus) that was transferred in a 1987 affiliation between St. Thomas and the seminary.

The main campus, built on a farm site once considered "far removed from town," is located where St. Paul's stately Summit Avenue meets the Mississippi River. The site was farmed by ex-Fort Snelling soldier William Finn, who received the property as a pension settlement after he accidentally shot himself in the hand while on guard duty. The beautifully landscaped campus has been used as a setting for two motion pictures.

The St. Paul south campus, situated west of Cretin Avenue and south of Summit Avenue, is the site of the new Frey Science and Engineering Center, the largest construction project in St. Thomas history. The two-building, 210,000-square-foot, \$37 million center opened in fall 1997 and serves as a gateway to the south campus. The western edge of the south campus borders the Mississippi Gorge Regional Park.

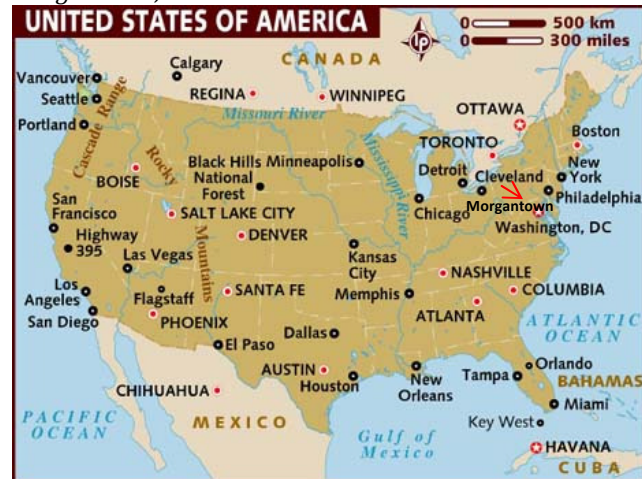
