Lille

EDHEC Business School was founded in 1906 in Lille, France's traditional industrial centre. Like its birthplace, the school has managed a seamless transition to the today's world. Lille is just half an hour from Brussels, one hour from Paris, and one hour and forty minutes from London.

Lille enjoys a vibrant and flourishing cultural life with its 1,100,000 inhabitants, 100,000 of which are students. The city has a dense economic fabric which has successfully adapted to today's world, and it is where some of the France's most dynamic businesses are located.

Nice

Nice is the fifth largest town in France with 350,000 inhabitants. It is a lively and colourful town with an Italian flavour, and focuses much of its energy on catering to international business and tourism.

EDHEC's campus is three minutes from the beach and just over an hour from the nearest ski slopes.

The campus in Nice is expanding rapidly. A second building has recently been added to the campus, as well as new residence halls for students.

Accommodation

The Maison St Laurent and Maison St Bernard are residence halls that belong to the Université Catholique de Lyon. Students living there can find a safe, friendly and homelike atmosphere. Both are located less than a ten minute walk from ESDES, which means you don't need to use the public transport on a daily basis.

Students are sometimes housed in bedrooms in residence halls that belong to the French Government (CROUS) in Résidence Allix or Delessert. These are state run services where students are fully independent among over 1,500 French or international students. This option is the cheapest and is ideal if you have a very limited budget along with little comfort demands.

We are in touch with some French families who want to welcome students for one semester and share the daily life of their home. Students will be put in contact with their French host family before they arrive in France and will share pictures. The number of places is extremely limited as students will only be housed by families UCLy know and trust. The students who have chosen this option in the past have been delighted by this authentic French experience.
