Opal card

Opal card is an electronic ticket that allows you to travel on all NSW bus, train, ferry and tram services. International students are eligible for the 'Adult' Opal card only, and are not eligible for the 'Concession' Opal card (except students on an Australian Government scholarship/sponsorship).

ACU Free Shuttle Bus

ACU runs a free shuttle bus for staff and students from Monday to Friday, between Strathfield station and the Strathfield campus. The bus leaves from the 'Kiss and Ride' stand in Strathfield Square on the south side of Strathfield train station.

Cheap, safe and convenient ways to travel at night

Sydney bus services operate along selected routes all night every night, with additional routes and services operating early on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Standard bus fares apply, except for route 300 which is transportnsw.info/travel-info/using-public-transport/late-night-services

NSW PHOTO CARD

The NSW Photo Card provides photo identification for people who do not hold a current NSW driver licence. It can be used for accessing licensed premises and for general identification, so you can leave your passport safe at home. The card costs \$52 (subject to change).

DRIVING/DRIVING LICENCE

International students can drive in Australia using a licence from their home country provided it is current and valid. If your licence is not written in English, you must also carry a certified translation in English (certified by the Community Relations Commission) or apply for an International Driving Permit from your home country. If you don't have an overseas licence and want to apply for a licence in Australia, you will need to apply through your state or territory motor registry:
