

Honours Grades

You will receive an individual grade for HUMA402 Introduction to Thesis Research and Design (NN, PA, CR, DI, HD) on your ACU transcript. Your percentage grade will contribute 1/8 of your final Honours mark.

You will receive individual grades and/or percentage marks for your Cross-Institutional units on the transcript supplied by your host university. On your ACU transcript, these units will be recorded as 'CG' – 'Credit granted.' If you have completed two 10 credit point Cross-Institutional units, your percentage marks for your Cross-Institutional units will each contribute 1/8 of your final Honours mark (2/8 in total). If you have completed one 20 credit point Cross-Institutional unit, your percentage mark for your Cross-Institutional unit will contribute 2/8 of your final Honours mark.

Your Honours thesis will be marked by two examiners, and you will receive the average of those two marks for your thesis. The grade you have achieved (NN, PA, CR, DI, HD) will be entered on your transcript next to each of your 'thesis' units. Your percentage mark for your Honours thesis will contribute 5/8 of your final Honours mark.

You will be awarded one of the grades below for your overall Honours mark, based on the weightings described above.
