

Requirements for Completing the Global Studies Sequence

This sequence consists of 120 credit points (cp) studied in Global Studies.

Global Studies units are common across all of the Global Studies double degrees but sit in different semesters depending on the particular double degree. Your course map shows when to study the Global Studies units alongside your other specified units and those of your major/minor (where relevant).
