CHOOSING THE RIGHT UNITS FOR YOUR COURSE

You must ensure you select units that are approved for your course. You can find this information in the course rules, the course map and additional sources such as Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) documents in your Course Enrolment Guide (CEG). If you are unsure, please contact your Course Coordinator for advice.

ACCELERATING YOUR DEGREE

You may be allowed to take Core Curriculum and/or elective units in the non-standard terms, such as Summer or Winter, which might help to shorten the duration of your course or spread your study load across the year. Check your course rules and course map for more information. Students enrolled in Arts degrees are permitted to take units in non-standard terms, subject to availability and meeting pre-requisite requirements.

ELECTIVE UNITS

An elective is a 'free choice' unit taken apart from those units required for your selected majors and/or minors. Generally, for degrees in the National School of Arts and Humanities, an elective may be any unit from this unit list document for which you have the pre-requisite. Global Studies degrees have their own list of approved units.

UNIT AVAILABILITY

This list provides information about units that are on offer in 2026. Not all units are offered every year.

PREREQUISITE UNITS

A prerequisite is a unit you must pass before you can enrol in a higher-level unit. The enrolment system will prevent you from enrolling in units for which you do not have the prerequisite.

DEFINITION OF A MAJOR AND A MINOR

A major is a total of 80 credit points (cp) in prescribed units in one discipline or approved interdisciplinary area, normally including at least 10 cp at introductory level, at least 40cp at 200-level and at least 20cp from 300-level.

A minor is a total of 40cp from prescribed units in one discipline or approved interdisciplinary area, normally including at least 10cp at introductory level and at least 20cp from 200/300-level.

You should check your course rules to confirm which majors/minors are permitted in your course.

UNIT DELIVERY MODES

The unit delivery mode describes the way that a unit is taught.

C - On Campus (was attendance)

Most learning activities or classes are delivered at a scheduled time, on campus or approved ACU delivery site, to enable in-person interactions. Activities will appear in a student's timetable.

M - Multi-mode

Learning activities are delivered through a planned mix of online and in-person classes, which may include full-day sessions and/or placements, to enable interaction. Activities that require attendance will appear in a student's timetable.

OU - Online unscheduled

Learning activities are accessible anytime, anywhere. These units are normally delivered fully online and will not appear in a student's timetable.

OS – Online scheduled

All class activities are held online, at scheduled times, and will require some attendance to enable online interaction. Activities will appear in a student's timetable.

HUMA330 COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

HUMA330 is a placement unit where students undertake a placement in an organisation in the community either during summer or semester 1 or semester 2. If you have a disability or additional needs that need to be considered in the choice of placement, please contact your course coordinator prior to enrolling.

Summer Term Placement Information: You will be placed in a Community Engaged project rather than a direct service placement. The project will be guided in class and completed in the three-week period specified. There will also be online live classes.

Semester One Placement Information: 25-hour direct service placement via opportunities available in the ACU Inplace portal plus online live classes in some weeks. You will need to apply for placements the week before semester begins. No self-sourced placements.

Semester Two Placement Information: 25-hour direct service placement via opportunities available in the ACU Inplace portal with some online modules OR Community Engaged project. The project will be guided in-class and completed over the semester. There will also be online live classes.

HUMA320 MAJOR CREATIVE PROJECT

HUMA320 is a compulsory capstone unit in the Bachelor of Creative Arts. You should not enrol in HUMA320 until your third year.

This unit prepares students for professional practice in the creative arts sector. The wonderful thing about HUMA320 is that students get to work on a project which requires skills from the various types of creative arts that they have explored throughout their degree. HUMA332 ARTS AND HUMANITIES SPECIAL PROJECT

This subject involves the completion of a 70-hour special project integrating academic learning, employability skills and attributes and an improved knowledge of organisations, workplace culture and career pathways in the Arts and Humanities. The project or placement gives a hands-on experience of work in the Arts and Humanities sector and is supplemented by workshops and/or excursions that focus on key cultural institutions, consultancies, government agencies, or local government/community organisations and will prepare students for the project or placement. Prior to the beginning of semester, ACU staff will have identified and engaged with appropriate project partners to develop a list of potential placements or projects that align with relevant majors in the National School of Arts and Humanities. Students will complete a 70-hour special project and use the rest of the semester to complete the tasks related to it. On completion of the subject, students will have completed and reported on an Arts or Humanities related project. The aim of the unit is to enhance students' employability skills including communication, interpersonal, analytical and problem-solving skills; organisational and time-management techniques; and an understanding of career planning and professional development in the Arts and Humanities.
