

Moving into Second Year of the Bachelor of Arts/MTeach

In second year:

- Students who are planning to finish both the BA and MTeach degrees in four years will need to enrol in the specified Education unit in summer term and the core curriculum unit in winter term in addition to the normal study load in semester one and two.
- If the 4-year model does not suit, you may take the same degree in 4.5 years without having to study in summer and winter.
- All majors require 2 x 300 level units.
- Be sure to complete one 300-level unit for your major in semester 2 of second year.

Moving into Third Year of the Bachelor of Arts/MTeach

In third year:

- Students who are planning to finish both the BA and MTeach degrees in four years will need
 to enrol in the community engaged unit in summer term in addition to the normal study load in
 semester one.
- The third-year map transitions from your Bachelor of Arts into your Master of Teaching, for students on the accelerated map. Your course coordinator will contact you about how to prepare for this and when to expect your Masters offer to arrive.
- If the 4-year model does not suit, you may take the same degree in 4.5 years without having to study in summer and winter.
- Remember: all majors require 2 x 300 level units.
- Be sure to complete the second 300-level unit for your major in <u>first semester</u>. Some majors such as English (ENGL331) and History (HIST308) have capstone units that you must complete in first semester.
- You will commence teaching placements in third year, if you have completed your Bachelor of Arts and move into the Masters part of your program.
