Information about Secondary Teaching Areas

To qualify to teach in a secondary school, you must complete one **First Teaching Area** and one **Second Teaching Area**. You will need to identify your two chosen areas at the beginning of your course when you select your first unit in Teaching Area 1 and Teaching Area 2.

In this double degree, your teaching area studies must also meet the requirements for a major and minor for your Bachelor of Arts.

To complete your Teaching Area studies, you must complete a sequence of units that include *Content studies* (completed via an Arts Major or Arts Minor) and *Curriculum, Pedagogy and Assessment studies*. Your course map shows the progression of 100-, 200- and 300-level units for each teaching area. You will also need to consider prerequisites that could limit which 200- or 300-level units you can study based on your earlier selections.

The following table outlines the differences between your first and second teaching areas.
