

Students wishing to complete this degree in full (3 years full time or equivalent)

The Bachelor of Educational Studies assists domestic and international students to work in education-education related fields, other than teaching. The degree prepares graduates to pursue a career in corporate training, educational consultancy, online learning, vocational and community education, curriculum writing, youth services or adult learning.

Students, completing the first year, may be eligible to apply for transfer into their chosen Bachelor-level Teaching degree. Students, completing the three-year program can progress to a postgraduate, initial-teacher-education qualification.

- Bachelor of Education (Primary)
- Bachelor of Education (Primary and Special Education)

Enrolment for your First Year of Study (Two Semesters)

The program has two key purposes:

1. to provide a broad understanding of educational theory and practice beyond Teacher Education and
2. to provide a pathway to ITE programs.

Attention must be paid to the selection of the fourth unit in the second-semester of the first year. Students seeking to utilise the program as a pathway are encouraged to select an elective that best supports their preferred teaching area.
