Transferring to your Teaching Degree

Applying to Transfer to your Teaching Degree

Eligibility:

- Domestic students can apply to transfer to their chosen Bachelor-level Teaching degree near the end of their first successful semester.
- International Students must complete the full Diploma before they are able to apply for their chosen Bachelor-level Teaching degree (due to VISA requirements)

Domestic students:

Submit a transfer request through the 'My Enrolment' tab in <u>Student Connect</u> by the required date. Applications open in mid-April for Semester 2 transfer into a Bachelor-level Teaching degree.

International students:

Submit a transfer request through the 'My Enrolment' tab in <u>Student Connect</u> by the required date. Applications open in mid-August for Semester 1 commencement in the following year.

There may be additional admission requirements for your course. Please view <u>The Entry</u> Requirements for Teaching Degrees for more information.

Receiving Credit for your Completed Units

If your transfer is successful, your previous studies will automatically be assessed by the National School of Education and ACU Enrolments, Credit will be applied for all units where possible. Once you have received the credit for your transfer, if you feel any units should have been credited but have not been, then please submit a <u>Credit Application Form</u> for these units specifically.

If the Pathway Guide has been followed correctly, credit will be applied for all completed relevant units, except for any enabling units (EDLA111, EDMA111, or EDST111).

Students commencing the Diploma in Semester 1

Some Bachelor-level Teaching degrees may not offer midyear entry. In this case, some students who commence the Diploma in semester 1 may be advised to remain enrolled in the Diploma for two semesters. During this time, the completed relevant units can be credited toward the new Bachelor-level Teaching degree.
