## Curriculum, Pedagogy and Assessment Units

Graduate teachers must apply for formal registration in the state or territory in which they wish to work. Recognised teaching areas for the purposes of teacher registration may vary from state to state. As such, not all CPA units are available on every campus. The availability of teaching areas on each campus is shown in the table on page 14 along with corresponding CPA sequences.

CPA units may be offered in multimode or fully online. Students are advised to preference multimode options where they are available.
