UNIT DELIVERY MODES

All units are delivered in On Campus mode, unless otherwise indicated in the map.

C - On Campus

M - Multi-mode

Learning activities are delivered through a planned mix of online and in-person classes, which may include full-day sessions and/or placements, to enable interaction. Activities that require attendance will appear in a student's timetable.

Learning activities are accessible anytime, anywhere. These units are normally delivered fully online and will **not** appear in a student's timetable.

OS - Online scheduled
