#### UNIT DELIVERY MODES

All units are delivered in multi-mode, unless otherwise indicated in the map.

#### C - On Campus

Most learning activities or classes are delivered at a scheduled time, on campus, to enable in-person interactions. Activities will appear in a student's timetable.

#### M - Multi-mode

Learning activities are delivered through a planned mix of online and in-person classes, which may include fullday sessions and/or placements, to enable interaction. Activities that require attendance will appear in a student's timetable.

#### OU - Online unscheduled

Learning activities are accessible anytime, anywhere. These units are normally delivered fully online and will **not** appear in a student's timetable.

#### OS – Online scheduled

All learning activities are held online, at scheduled times, and will require some attendance to enable online interaction. Activities will appear in a student's timetable.

#### PREREQUISITES

- Prerequisites ('Pre:') are added in italics.
- Prerequisites are other units that you must have passed before enrolling in the unit.
- You will not be able to enrol in a unit in Student Connect if you do not meet the prerequisite requirements. (This will help stop you from enrolling in units incorrectly). You can find out about unit prerequisite requirements in your Course Enrolment Guide.
