1.2. Selection of Study Area Units

Once you have chosen a study area you would like to undertake a Minor in, you must select your minor units. Your four minor units must include at least one 10cp unit on the 100-level and at least two 10cp units at an advanced level (200-or 300- level units). Please note that you can only choose those units for your Minor whose pre-requisite requirements you fulfil. Pre-requisites are other units that you must have passed *before* enrolling in the unit.

Commencing full-time students should select one minor unit for Semester 1 2021 and one minor unit for Semester 2 2021 in the discipline they have chosen. Continuing students should continue to complete minor units consistent with the discipline they have chosen in the previous year; they will select one minor unit for Semester 1 2021 and one for Semester 2 2021.
