# 2026 Unit Selection Information Melbourne and Strathfield

## 1. Selection of a Minor

### 1.1. Selection of a Study Area or Discipline (Commencing students only)

As part of your course, you need to complete a Minor. A Minor is a total of 4 units (40cp) from prescribed units in one discipline or an approved interdisciplinary minor. To complete a minor, you need at least 10cp at a 100-level (i.e. XXXX1xx), at least 20cp at a 200- or 300-level (i.e. XXXX2xx or XXXX3xx). The remaining 10cp can be completed at any level.

The Minor can be selected from a wide range of study areas - other than Psychology - available at ACU. The Minors you can chose from are listed in Table 1 below.

#### 1.2. Selection of Units

Once you have chosen a study area, you must select your Minor units.

Your four Minor units must include at least one 10cp unit on the 100-level and at least two units at an advanced level (200- or 300-level units). Please note that you can only choose units whose pre-requisite requirements you fulfil. Pre-requisites are other units that you must have passed *before* enrolling in the unit and are listed under the unit name in the course map.

**Commencing** full-time students should select one Minor unit for Semester 1 2026 and one Minor unit for Semester 2 2026 in the study area they have chosen.

**Continuing** students should continue to complete Minor units consistent with the study area they chose in the previous year. This means full-time students should select the third unit of the Minor for Semester 1 2026 and the fourth unit for Semester 2 2026.

## 2. Selection of Elective Units

In the Bachelor of Psychology (Honours), in addition to selecting a Minor, you will need to choose 30 credit points in elective units. Of these 30cp, you need to select at least 10cp from the list of Psychology electives. The other 20cp can be a combination of Psychology electives or general electives.

First year students should enrol in a general elective rather than a psychology elective.

#### 2.1. Selection of a General Elective

A general elective can be any undergraduate unit offered at the university that you are eligible to enrol in - that is you must meet any prerequisite requirements for it. The general elective *cannot* be a unit that is required as part of your degree or a unit that forms part of your chosen minor.

The easiest way to select a general elective is to look at the units offered as part of other minors. For first year students we recommend that you pick a general elective at the 100-level (i.e. XXXX1XX).

For your second general elective, you can also pick a unit from the psychology electives listed in Table 3 above.

### 2.2. Selection of a Psychology Elective

Psychology electives are normally taken in years 2 or 3 of the course (not in first year). Please refer to the table below to find a suitable Psychology Elective Unit on your campus.
