The Bachelor of Social Work course was reviewed in 2019.

Students who have completed the 1<sup>st</sup> placement (SWTP220) by 2019 will continue in the existing degree structure.

New students and those who have not completed SWTP220 in 2019 will move into new degree structure from 2020. If HLSC220 has been completed early under old structure, it will count as an elective in new structure.

From 2021, you will not be able to enrol in a unit in Student Connect if you don't meet the prerequisite requirements. This will help stop you from enrolling in units incorrectly.
