## How to use the recredential roadmap

- 1 Click on your profession. You will see a step by step process of how to gain accreditation to work in Australia.
- 2 Click on the 'Resources' tab, top right, for information on how to have your qualification recognised in Australia.
- 3 Click on the 'English' tab, top right, for additional information on English Language test providers.

There's a lot of different sources that you might explore to have your qualifications recognised in Australia. We've collated them here for you, to make the process of accreditation easier.
