The application form for organisation-specific projects asks the following questions:

1. APPLICATION CONTACT

2. RESEARCH THEME

- Does your organisation or any of the proposed partners have a Human Research Ethics Committee (HREC)?

- Does the organisation have an existing relationship with ACU? If yes, please provide brief details

- Do you intend the researchers to collect information from minors (persons under 18 years of age) for this research?

5. COLLABORATION

SESU projects are intended to be wholly collaborative:

- Please a) outline the expertise and experience that your organisation can bring to the project; and b) nominate one staff member to join the project team as the lead from your organisation (this is an in-kind contribution from your organisation; without remuneration from ACU). While more people from your organisation may be involved in the project, your organisation's project lead will attend project meetings with the ACU team, commit time to help shape project and report back on project progress to their colleagues as needed. - What financial contributions does your organisation intend to make to the research project? [150 word limit]
- List any skills or expertise you are seeking assistance with in requesting this research (to help us to match you appropriately with our researchers). [150 word limit]

If yes, please tell us how your organisations are connected, how long they have been working together, and which shared goals they have for the project. We recognise that different organisations might play different roles in the project based on their connection to the research topic, and if that's the case, please let us know how you see each organisation engaging with the research.
