This course provides the skills and knowledge for early childhood workers (currently employed with a Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care CHC30113) who wish to upskill and be responsible for the design and implementation of early childhood education and care programs. This course is suitable for people who are looking to work and study part-time.

DURATION AND MODE OF DELIVERY

The course is 12 months part-time for individuals currently working in the childcare sector and holding a Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30113).

The course is delivered online with weekly access to the trainer and attendance on-campus one day per month.

On completion you will be issued with the nationally accredited award of CHC50113 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care.

PATHWAYS TO FURTHER STUDIES

On achieving competency in all units of the Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care, students will be offered a Commonwealth Supported Place in the:

- Bachelor of Early Childhood Education (Birth to Five Years) at ACU with 80 credit points towards the degree, or
- Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood and Primary) at ACU with 60 credit points towards the degree.
