Speech pathology services at the ACU Health Clinic (Banyo) run clinics for Adults who experience communication or swallowing difficulties.

ACU Health Clinics are university teaching facilities. Our clinic has been specifically designed to provide state-of-the-art facilities for our clients receiving health services delivered in a student teaching context.

Our clinical programs are delivered by speech pathology students under the supervision of professional practice educators who are qualified Speech Pathologists with extensive experience in their respective fields.

### WHAT WE OFFER

Adult Speech Pathology Clinic specialising in the assessment and management of:

- Speech difficulties (dysarthria, dyspraxia or reduced clarity): associated with neurological or other conditions
- Language disorders (aphasia): commonly associated with a stroke
- Cognitive Communication Disorders: associated with Dementia, TBI or other neurological conditions
- Voice Disorders: associated with Parkinson's disease and other medical conditions
- Swallowing disorders (dysphagia): may be associated with neurological conditions such as stroke, Parkinson's disease, Motor Neurone disease (MND), Multiple sclerosis, Myasthenia gravis, Progressive supranuclear palsy or Huntington's disease
- Swallowing or talking difficulty associated with Chronic Cough
- LOUD Crowd for people living with Parkinson's disease
- Certified Speak Out Provider

### COST

\$42 per individual session.

\$10 for each LOUD Crowd group session.

Because our fees are low, we do not typically offer a concession rate. However, reduced rates may be arranged for special circumstances so please speak to your supervising clinician if payment of fees is an issue for you. We can discuss an arrangement to suit your circumstances.
