

# ACU Health Clinics – Brisbane SPOT Infant Development Clinic

Speech pathology and occupational therapy (SPOT) services at our ACU Health Clinic (Banyo) run development clinics for infants and children aged birth to two years. Services include individual developmental assessment, customised intervention and education for families and carers.

ACU Health Clinics are university teaching facilities. Our clinic has been specifically designed to provide state-of-the-art facilities for our clients receiving health services delivered in a student teaching context.

Our clinical programs are delivered by speech pathology and occupational therapy students under the supervision of professional practice educators who are all fully-qualified and experienced health professionals in their respective fields.

### SPOT developmental services are available for:

 assessment, monitoring and therapy provided for infants experiencing difficulties in any of these areas:

- · interaction with caregivers
- communication
- play skills (including fine motor and thinking skills)
- self-regulation (including difficulties with being alert or sleeping)
- · progression of feeding
- multidisciplinary developmental assessment and interventions including physiotherapy
- group based enrichment programs to stimulate best possible language and cognitive play skills.
