SPOT Feeding Clinic

Speech pathology (SP) / Occupational Therapy (OT) services at our ACU Health Clinic (Banyo) run feeding clinics for children aged birth to 16 years. The feeding clinic will run as a Speech Pathology service across the year, with an interdisciplinary Speech Pathology and Occupational Therapy model available at certain times of the year. Services include assessment and intervention for difficulties with swallowing, feeding and mealtimes.

ACU Health Clinics are university teaching facilities. Our clinic has been specifically designed to provide state-of-the-art facilities for our clients receiving health services delivered in a teaching context.

Our clinical programs are delivered by speech pathology and/or occupational therapy students under the supervision of professional practice educators who are all fully-qualified and experienced Speech Pathologists or Occupational therapists. Feeding clinic services are available for:

Fussy eaters:

- taking a long time to finish feeding/eating
- refusing to eat or drink
- only eating foods with specific textures, colours, tastes or smells
- not eating at mealtimes but snacking excessively at other times
- limited variety of foods eaten.

Problem feeders:

- crying or fussing when feeding
- problems with breast or bottle feeding
- difficulty chewing food
- difficulty drinking
- difficulty transitioning from bottle to cup
- difficulty introducing solids.

Food school groups:

- food play
- introduction to new foods.

COST

Our 5 week Food School Group is \$100 for all sessions (inclusive of food provided and parent education resources).

A \$42 fee will apply for individual initial assessment appointment and any subsequent individual sessions with our speech pathology and occupational therapy students.

Self-referrals and referrals from other health professionals. Priority will be given to referrals from clients and families who are unable to access private services.
