The Xavier Centre is part of the Faculty of Theology and Philosophy at Australian Catholic University, and works with partners and participants across Australia to deliver co-constructed, non-award formation opportunities.

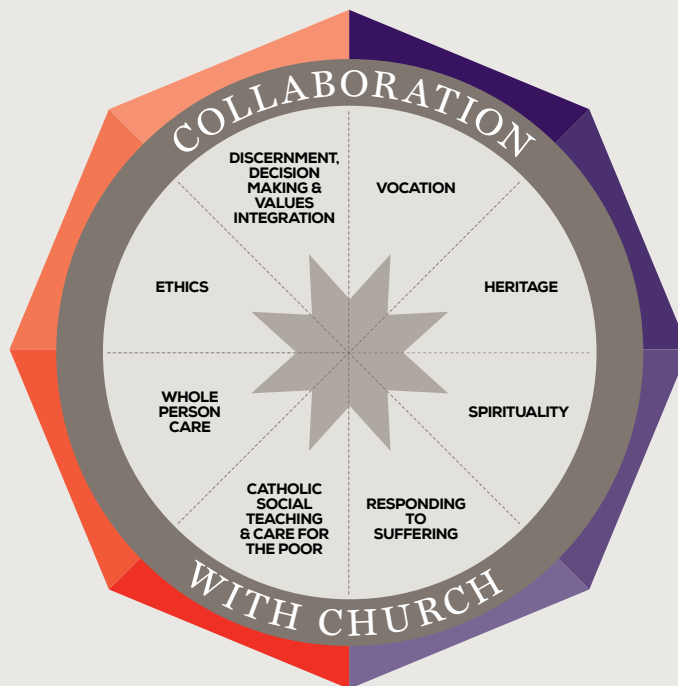
