These workshops prepare new and experienced Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to exercise their ministry well.

ACU's experienced liturgy instructors will guide you through engaging material in a friendly and supportive learning environment during this free weekend workshop (Friday night and Saturday) sponsored by the Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne. Because ministry occurs in a particular location with its own expectations and procedures, this program will be complemented by a local practicum run by your parish priest (or designate) to help apply your learning. A very brief online introduction has also been prepared for you.

A five-year certification is provided to those who complete all components of the program.

The EMHC (Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion) training program prepares knowledgeable, skilled and hospitable Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. This program promotes a deep understanding of the Mass and the role of the Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion in serving the assembly.
