Dear staff and students

Following yesterday's press conference by Premier Daniel Andrews that outlined specific impacts on a range of industries, and further clarification from government officials, we have an important update for you on placements and practical classes in Victoria.

- Placements can continue, and students will be advised individually by their faculty on any changes.
- Practical classes can continue on the Melbourne and Ballarat campuses. Timetables will be revised to ensure that all classes finish in time to allow staff and students to return home before the 8pm curfew.
- Students attending placements or practical classes will need to carry a revised letter from the university, along with their student ID. Students can download their letter from the student portal. Staff will need to carry their staff ID and a worker permit, which will be issued by the university shortly.

We understand that it can be frustrating and difficult to stay across the rapidly changing COVID-19 advice and restrictions, and we appreciate your patience as we work to clarify and pass on the most recent guidance.

We will continue to communicate when more details come to hand. I encourage you to remain engaged with our communications and FAQs page which we are updating as information changes.
