

HOW TO COMPLETE AN ADOBE PDF FILLABLE FORM ELECTRONICALLY

Note: Correctly completed electronic forms will experience a faster turnaround.

This ACU International fillable PDF form has been designed to be completed and emailed using Adobe Acrobat Reader DC using a Computer. Mobile devices are not recommended for submitting this form.

You can download Adobe Acrobat Reader DC for free from:

For PC or Mac Computer/Laptop – Adobe Website- get.adobe.com/reader/

Note: If you do not have an Adobe Account and do not wish to create one, you can skip the account creation step.

1. Download the fillable PDF form

- a) Download and save the file as a PDF onto your device (take note of where you have saved it)
- b) If the form has opened in a web browser or another program (not Adobe Acrobat Reader DC), you will need to close it

2. Open the fillable form in Adobe Acrobat Reader DC

- a) Open Adobe Acrobat Reader DC
- b) Open the fillable pdf form you have just saved

3. Complete the fillable form in Adobe Acrobat Reader DC

- a) When Adobe Acrobat DC opens the PDF, all of the fillable fields will be highlighted. Items that are required are highlighted with red boxes. Items that are optional are highlighted with black boxes (do not use Fill & Sign)
- b) You will now be able to click on the fields and fill out the form to completion
- c) Computer When you have completed the form, click the "SUBMIT FORM" button. This will open a new email with your form attached. Attach further documentation to the email if required Mobile device When you have completed the form, the submit button will not work, you will need to save your form and attach it to a new email message. Attach further documentation to the email if required
- d) Email the form to the email address as instructed. This email must be sent from your verified email account* as we cannot process applications sent from another email account. You should check your email Sent Box to confirm your email and form have been sent
- e) You can now save and close your completed form

* Verified Email Accounts

- Current ACU students must use their ACU Student Email account
- Applicants must use the email account provided in their Application for admission
