

HOW TO COMPLETE AN ADOBE PDF FILLABLE FORM ELECTRONICALLY

This ACU International fillable PDF form has been designed to be completed, saved and emailed using Adobe Acrobat Reader DC.

You can download Adobe Acrobat Reader DC for free from:

Note: If you do not have an Adobe Account and do not wish to create one, then just click the X when prompted to create an account.

1. Download the fillable PDF form

- a) Click on the form you would like to complete.
- b) Your web browser will then open the form.
- c) Do not complete the form while it is open in your web browser. Instead, save the form as a PDF onto your device (take note of where you have saved it).

2. Open the fillable form in Adobe Acrobat Reader DC

- a) Open Adobe Acrobat Reader DC
- b) Open the fillable pdf form you have just saved

3. Complete the fillable form in Adobe Acrobat Reader DC

- a) When Adobe Acrobat DC opens the PDF, all of the fillable fields will be highlighted. Items that are required are highlighted with red boxes. Items that are optional are highlighted with black boxes.
- b) You will now be able to click on the fields and fill out the form to completion.
- c) When you have completed the form, click the "Save" button.
- d) You're done! Now simply email the form and attached the required documentation to the email address as instructed.

Note:

- If you are a current ACU student, all emails to ACU must be sent from your ACU Student Email account.
- If you are a future ACU student, then your email must come from the email account specified in your Application for admission.
