

ACU Sport Facilities – Terms of Use

STRATHFIELD SPORT FIELDS

The following terms apply to all ACU sport facilities. By accessing these facilities, you agree to the terms stated below. Defying these terms may result in being required to leave the venue.

Use of Facilities: All persons making use of these ACU sport facilities must:

- a) Use the sport facilities only for their intended purpose, or as directed by ACU.
- b) Leave the sport facility in the same condition as it was when it was accessed.
- c) Not climb on fences, backstops or buildings.
- d) Ensure all repetitive drills take place away from the goal mouths when using natural grass fields.
- e) Not enter or use any area which has been roped off or otherwise indicated to be out of bounds.

Advertising: All signage is to be approved by ACU prior to being displayed at venue. ACU reserves the right to remove any non-compliant signage without notice.

Alcohol, smoking and drug use: Alcohol, drugs and tobacco are not permitted on field of play or in the areas surrounding the sport facility, including change rooms, spectator viewing areas or along the sidelines. Event permits that include alcohol are at the discretion of ACU. Under no circumstance is glass permitted within the sport facility.

Children: All children under 15 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian (aged 18 years or older) at all times.

Animals: Animals are not permitted at any sport facilities with the exception of Guide/Assist dogs or otherwise as permitted by law.

Behaviour: Un-sportsman like behaviour, swearing and bad language by players, coaching staff or spectators is not welcome or tolerated on the field of play, sidelines or spectator areas. Offensive or inappropriate behaviour will result in immediate eviction from the facility. CCTV is in operation 24/7.

Filming: The use of cameras, drones, audio or video recorders and other recording devices within the sport facility is strictly prohibited unless express written permission has been granted by ACU.

Fire Prevention: No naked flames or fireworks should be brought onto the field of play. No person shall kindle or maintain an outdoor cooking fire. Gas/electric BBQs may only be used after express written permission has been granted by ACU.

Footwear: Appropriate footwear is required to be worn at all times. Football boots with moulded studs or cleats are perfect for synthetic turf. High heels and football boots with metal (steel or aluminum) studs are permitted for use on synthetic turf.

Inclement Weather: ACU reserves the right to close the sport facility due to inclement weather.

Litter: All rubbish must be removed from the sport facility after each use.

Lost Property All lost property items should be left with ACU security. You agree that you are solely responsible for the security of your property at the facility and ACU is not responsible for any loss or damage including any theft. ACU is not liable for any damage to your property under any circumstances.

Sound and Electronics: No amplified sound is permitted in ACU campus facilities without the express written prior consent of ACU. All portable electronic equipment and appliances must undergo tag and testing before use at any venue.

Structures: All marquees and structures must be anchored using weights.

- a) Pegs, spokes or any sharp objects are not permitted on playing surface unless prior permission has been granted by ACU.
- b) All structures over 3x3m require insurance, verified by a Certificate of Currency and engineer sign off.
- c) For synthetic surfaces, weight bearing activities/covers should not be placed on the turf until the last possible minute before an event and removed as soon as possible afterwards. After covers have been removed the turf fibres should be brushed using the ACS brush to return the fibres to their correct position.
- d) Only approved seating and chairs are allowed on to the synthetic surface at any time, chairs or seating must have a wide base so as not to pierce or damage the layers of the surface.
