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ABOUT THE COURSE

The Diploma in Educational Studies (Tertiary Preparation) has been developed for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students and will be delivered at Australian Catholic University's (ACU) Strathfield Campus. Successful completion of this course will guarantee you entry into the Bachelor of Primary Education (Away From Base).

This diploma is offered in Away From Base mode, which enables you to live and work in your local community while studying and attending six, one-week residentials in Sydney over the duration of the course.

COURSE STRUCTURE

The course is comprised of three semesters of study, including six residential blocks at our Strathfield Campus. You will also be required to undertake considerable self-directed learning at home.

TUTORIAL ASSISTANCE

The Indigenous Higher Education Unit (Yalbalinga) will match you with a suitable tutor who will assist you with your studies. Your tutor will support you on campus and once you are back in your community.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

If you are living 90 minutes or more away from the University by public transport, you are eligible for travel, accommodation and meal allowances for residentials.
