ABOUT THE COURSE

The Diploma in Educational Studies (Tertiary Preparation) has been developed for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students and will be delivered at Australian Catholic University's (ACU) Brisbane Campus. Successful completion of this course will guarantee you entry into the Bachelor of Early Childhood Education (Birth to Five Years) or the Bachelor of Educational Studies.

This course is offered in Away From Base mode, which enables you to live and work in your local community while studying and attending six, one-week residentials in Brisbane over the duration of the course.

COURSE STRUCTURE

The course is comprised of three semesters of study, including six residential blocks at our Brisbane Campus. You will also be required to undertake considerable self-directed learning at home.

On campus, you will have access to the purpose-built early childhood education room, where learning simulations are held for students.

TUTORIAL ASSISTANCE

The Indigenous Higher Education Unit (Weemala) will match you with a suitable tutor who will assist you with your studies. Your tutor will support you on campus and once you are back in your community.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

If you are living 90 minutes or more away from the University by public transport, you may be eligible for travel, accommodation and meal allowances during your residentials.
