Ranks on the GCE are calculated on the basis that at the Advanced Level (A2): A*=6, A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1, and must include results in minimum of two advanced Level (A2) and up to two (2) at Advanced Subsidiary Level (AS) subjects. AS Level subject is half of that assigned at Advanced Level (A2) – A*=3, A=2.5, B=2, C=1.5, D=1, E=0.5. Subjects at Advanced Level (A2) must be taken in the same academic year. AS Level subjects may be taken in the same or previous academic year. A subject taken at both AS Level and Advanced Level is only counted once for aggregate score.

<b>International Baccalaureate</b>	Successful completion of International Baccalaureate with a minimum of 24 over six subjects.
<b>West African Senior School Certificate</b>	Maximum aggregate of 12 in the best six subjects.

<b>Bahrain</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Bangladesh</b>	Higher Secondary or Intermediate Certificate. Minimum GPA 4.00 based on a 5-point GPA scale.
<b>Belarus</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Belgium</b>	Belgian Certificate of Access to Higher Education. Minimum grade average of 10 on 20 point scale.
<b>Bhutan</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Bolivia</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Bosnia and Herzegovina</b>	Matura or Secondary School Leaving Certificate with minimum aggregate score of 50.

<b>Burma (Myanmar)</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Cambodia</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.

<b>Croatia</b>	Croatian Matura with minimum aggregate score of 4.5. Ranks on the Matura are calculated on the basis that at the Higher Level grades: Excellent = 8, Very Good = 6, Good = 4, Pass = 2, Insufficient = 1, Basic Level grades: Excellent = 5, Very Good = 4, Good = 3, Pass = 2, Insufficient = 1.
<b>Cuba</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Cyprus</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Czech Republic</b>	Czech Republic and Slovakian Maturita with grade average of 4.0 or lower. Ranks on the Maturita are calculated on the basis of Excellent = 1, Very Good = 2, Good = 3, Poor = 4, Fail = 5.
<b>Denmark</b>	Senior High School (Studentereksames) with minimum grade average of 6.0 on 13 point scale.
<b>Ecuador</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Egypt</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>El Salvador</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.

<b>Fiji</b>	Fiji Form 7 (2012 and earlier) with minimum aggregate score of 228 in the best 4 subjects (one of which must include English). Subject grades are converted as A=80, B=65, C=50 or 1-2=80, 3-4=65, 5-6=50; OR Fiji Year 13 Certificate (2013 onwards) with minimum aggregate score of 228 in the best 4 subjects (one of which must include English). Subject grades are converted as A+=90, A=80, B+=70, B=60, C=50, D=30.
<b>Finland</b>	Finnish Secondary School Leaving Certificate - Overall grade average of 6 in final year results OR Finnish Matriculation Certificate - Overall grade of 3.3.
<b>France</b>	French Baccalaureate with minimum average of 10.5.
<b>French Polynesia</b>	Refer to France.
<b>Gabon</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Georgia</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Germany</b>	German Abitur with minimum overall grade 3.2 or lower.
<b>Ghana</b>	Refer to GCE 'A' Levels OR West African Senior School Certificate.

<b>Greece</b>	Apolytirio Geniko Lykeio and General Entrance exam with minimum score of 200 OR Apolytirio Geniko Lykeio and Greek Certificate of Access with minimum aggregate score of 16.
<b>Hong Kong</b>	Hong Kong A Level (2011 and earlier) with minimum aggregate score 2 on the best three subjects. Ranks on the GCE are calculated on the basis that at the Advanced Level A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, D = 2, E = 1. Advanced Supplementary level results may be included in the aggregate and contribute the equivalent of half of a subject taken at Advanced Level – A = 2.5, B = 2, C = 1.5, D = 1, E = 0.5. Subjects must be taken in the same academic year (October to June) OR Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) with minimum aggregate score 12 based on the best five subjects including three core subjects (Chinese Language, English Languages, Mathematics and Liberal Arts). Category B and C subjects are not counted. Grades for all subjects except Mathematics are counted as follows: Level 5** and Level 5* = 6, Level 5 = 5, Level 4 = 4, Level 3 = 3, Level 2 = 2 and Level 1 = 1. <b>Kiribati</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Korea</b>	College Scholastic Ability Test (CSAT) (2005 - 2017) with minimum overall standardized score (pyojunjumsu) of 290, based on the results in Korean Language, Math and Foreign Language (English); College Scholastic Ability Test (CSAT) (2018 onwards) with minimum overall Standard score 260 of Language Arts(Korean Language) and Mathematics, and maximum Grade 4 in English; Senior High School Certificate with minimum overall average of 70% in final year results; Graduation Equivalency Examination (Geom Jeong Go Si) with minimum overall 80% of 5 best subjects
<b>Laos</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Lebanon</b>	Lebanese Baccalaureate with minimum overall grade of 12.
<b>Libya</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Liechtenstein</b>	Liechtenstein Maturitaszeugnis with minimum grade average of 2.8.
<b>Lithuania</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Luxembourg</b>	Luxemborg Diplome de Fen D'Etudes with minimum grade average of 26.
<b>Macau</b>	Form 6 (also called Certificate of Higher Secondary Education) with minimum grade average of 70% in best 4 academic subjects.
<b>Macedonia</b>	Macedonian Matura School Leaving Certificate with minimum aggregate score of 40. Aggregate is calculated as follows: (8 x final year school grade average) + (12 x matura examination mark).
<b>Malaysia</b>	Malaysian Sijil Tinggi Pelajaran Malaysia (STPM) - A minimum score will be calculated based on the number of subjects completed in the same academic year. The scores required are 7 for one subject, 4 for two subjects, 4 for three subjects and 3 for four or more subjects. Ranks for the Malaysian STPM are calculated on the basis that at the Advanced Level A = 7, A- = 6, B+ = 5, B = 4, B- = 3, C+ = 2, C = 1, with partial passes C-, D+ and D = 0. <b>Nepal</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies; OR Completion of the Higher Secondary School Certificate with minimum overall GPA of 3.00/4.00 or 75% entry to undergraduate programs, except: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Initial Teacher Education (ITE) or professionally accredited programs within the Faculty of Education and Arts;</li> <li>• Programs that require professional accreditation to practice as health care professional within Faculty of Health Sciences;</li> <li>• Law programs within the Faculty of Law and Business.</li> </ul>
<b>Netherlands</b>	Duth Diploma of Pre-University Education with minimum overall grade average of 5.0.

<b>New Zealand</b>	Assessed individually.
<b>Nigeria</b>	West African Senior School Certificate or Nigerian Senior School Certificate - Aggregate score of 12 or lower in the best six subjects.
<b>Norway</b>	Norwegian Certificate of Completion of Upper Secondary School Examinations with minimum grade average of 2.5 on 6 point scale.
<b>Oman</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Pakistan</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Papua New Guinea</b>	Papua New Guinea Upper Secondary School Certificate with minimum grade average of 3.0 on 4 point scale. Grades based on: A = 4, B = 3, C = 2, D = 1, E = 0.
<b>Peru</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Philippines</b>	(2017 and earlier) Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies; (2018 and onwards) High School Diploma (K-12) (Academic track or Arts & Design track) with a minimum of 85% score; OR (2018 and onwards) High School Diploma (K-12) with minimum total score of 1010 for SAT I Critical Reading, SAT I: Mathematical and SAT I: Writing test scores
<b>Poland</b>	Polish Matura Certificate (2005 and onwards) with minimum average grade 55 in the written and oral examinations for all compulsory subjects presented.
<b>Portugal</b>	Portuguese Certificate of Secondary Education with minimum grade average of 9.
<b>Romania</b>	Romanian Upper Secondary Leaving Certificate with minimum grade average of 5.0.
<b>Russia</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Saudi Arabia</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Scotland</b>	Scottish Qualifications Certificate with minimum aggregate score of 7.0. Grades for National Courses at Higher level are counted as follows: A=3, B=2, C=1, Grades for National Courses at Advanced higher Level are counted as follows: A=5.5, B=4.5, C=3.5 and D=2.5.
<b>Seychelles</b>	Refer to GCE 'A' Levels.
<b>Singapore</b>	Singapore-Cambridge GCE A Levels with minimum aggregate score 7 in at least 3 H2 subjects and 1 H1 subject. (Course prerequisite still apply.) Aggregate to be calculated on the basis that A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, D = 2, E = 1 for Higher 2 (H2) subjects. U (ungraded) and S (Sub pass) are fail grades with a notional value of 0. The notional value of a Higher 1 (H1) subject is half of that assigned to a Higher 2 (H2) subject, where A = 2.5, B = 2, C = 1.5, D = 1, E = 0.5. Higher 3 (H3) subjects are not included in the calculation of the aggregate.
<b>Slovakia</b>	Czech Republic and Slovakian Maturita with grade average of 4.0 or lower. Ranks on the Maturita are calculated on the basis of Excellent = 1, Very Good = 2, Good = 3, Poor = 4, Fail = 5.
<b>Slovenia</b>	Slovenian Matura or Secondary School Leaving Certificate with minimum aggregate score of 16 in maximum five subjects.
<b>South Africa</b>	South African National Senior Certificate (2008 and onwards) with minimum average mark 50% and eligible for admission to higher education (Bachelor degree, Diploma or Higher Certificate) in South Africa.

<b>Spain</b>	Spanish University Orientation Year with minimum grade average of 4.7 OR Spanish Titulo with a de Acceso a La Universidad (2010 and onwards) with ACCESS score of 7.2. Calculated as follows: (Bachillerato mark x 0.6) + (PAU x 0.4).
<b>Sri Lanka</b>	Sri Lankan General Certificate of Education A Level (2000 and onwards) with minimum aggregate score 7 in best three advanced level subjects excluding General English or the Common General Test. Aggregate to be calculated on the basis that A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, S = 1. Must be on one sitting.
<b>Sudan</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Sweden</b>	Swedish Secondary School Certificate (2014 and onwards) with minimum GPA 11.7. Grades based on: A = 20, B = 17.5, C = 15, D = 12.5, E = 10, F = 0.
<b>Switzerland</b>	Swiss Cantonal Maturity Certificate or Cantonal Commercial Maturity Certificate with minimum GPA 4.0 OR Swiss Federal Maturity Certificate (2012 and onwards) with minimum aggregate score of 52.
<b>Taiwan</b>	Taiwanese General Scholastic Aptitude Test (GSAT) with minimum aggregate score of 50. GSAT Score is calculated from results for Chinese, English, Mathematics, Natural Sciences and Social Sciences; OR Senior High School Diploma with minimum aggregate mark of 75% in final year results.
<b>Tanzania</b>	Tanzanian Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education with minimum aggregate score of 6. Ranks are calculated on the basis that at the Advanced Level (A2) A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1, and must include results in Advanced Level (A2) and Principal Level only.
<b>Thailand</b>	Thailand Certificate of Secondary Education with minimum mark 62 or GPA 2.5 on 4 point scale.
<b>Tonga</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Turkey</b>	Successful completion of a recognised pre-tertiary or foundation program OR successful completion of one year of study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution is required in addition to the completion of High School Studies.
<b>Uganda</b>	Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education with minimum aggregate score of 6. Ranks are calculated on the basis that at the Advanced Level (A2) A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1, and must include results in Advanced Level (A2) and Principal Level only.
