

Student Veteran Panel

What is the Student Veterans Panel?

As part of the Veterans Transitions Program (VTP), commencing student veterans will participate in a one-day orientation to introduce them to university services and experiences. As part of this orientation there will be a 'student veteran's panel' which is comprised of student veterans who have completed more than one year of study and would like to share their unique experiences with the commencing cohort. The panel will run for 45-minutes with questions relating to individual student experience, coping strategies and advice. There will also be an opportunity for the commencing students to ask questions to the panel.

What is the role?

If you would like to participate in this role you would be expected to:

Be available on the day of the orientation (06/07/2020) for the duration of the day

Be happy and willing to share your positive experiences with the commencing students in an open forum

Be happy and willing to answer questions asked from the panel moderator and commencing students

Ensure that experiences are constructive and helpful to the commencing students

Complete an experience questionnaire at the conclusion of the day

Be in your 2nd year of study or above

Good communication skills

Enthusiastic about helping others

Happy to help support other student veterans in their studies
