ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR MICHAEL REYNOLDS

Associate Professor Michael Reynolds is Deputy Head, School of Allied Health (NSW) in ACU's Faculty of Health Sciences. He is a Wiradjuri academic and serves as Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Curriculum and Pedagogy Coordinator (Physiotherapy). With professional foundations in sports and exercise physiotherapy, his current work spans higher education leadership, curriculum development and strengthening cultural capability across health professions education. He has also held multiple governance and advisory roles and is currently Board Chair of the Australian Physiotherapy Council.

Associate Professor Reynolds' research focuses on understanding and improving the conditions that enable Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander students to succeed in higher education.

His doctoral project, undertaken in partnership with ACU's Institute for Positive Psychology and Education (IPPE), examines how self-determination, self-concept and culturally grounded learning environments influence progression and degree completion.

Associate Professor Reynolds leads initiatives to embed Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander perspectives across allied health programs. This extends to strengthening of pathways and representation for Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander students and graduates within the higher education and health sectors. In recognition of these contributions, he was awarded the Indigenous Allied Health Australia's Local Champion Award in 2023 and Australian Physiotherapy Association NSW Branch Award in 2018.



PROFESSOR LARISSA MCLEAN DAVIES

Professor Larissa McLean Davies is an internationally recognised scholar and higher education leader with a deep commitment to education as a force for transformation. She brings to ACU a blend of leadership experience, scholarly distinction and sector-wide impact. Prior to joining ACU, Professor McLean Davies held senior roles at the University of Melbourne, including Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Education, Associate Dean (Learning and Teaching) and inaugural Professor of Teacher Education.

Professor McLean Davies' leadership has shaped

major strategic initiatives in teacher education, curriculum innovation and workforce planning. She has successfully led large interdisciplinary research teams and established research labs exploring the intersection of literature, literacy and social justice. She has driven national reforms in teacher education, and continues to lead projects on Indigenous literatures, climate education and sustainability.

Professor McLean Davies is committed to fostering flourishing lives, thriving communities and an ethical future through transformative education.



PROFESSOR DAVID SMITH

Professor David Smith is Professor and Executive Dean of the Faculty of Law and Business at ACU. Immediately prior to taking on this role, he was Dean of the School of Accounting, Information Systems and Supply Chain at RMIT University. He previously held professorial appointments at the University of Queensland and Monash University.

Professor Smith is an internationally recognised researcher in the field of management accounting, has been published widely in leading accounting journals and is on the editorial board

of several leading accounting journals. He has received competitive external funding for his research from a variety of sources, including the Australian Research Council (ARC).

Professor Smith is a former board member of the Accounting and Finance Association of Australia and New Zealand (AFAANZ) and a former chair of the Chartered Institute of Management Accountants Centre of Excellence (Australasia). He is a Fellow of Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand.



PROFESSOR ROBYN HORNER

Professor Robyn Horner is a teaching and research academic within the School of Theology, and a member of the Institute for Religion and Critical Inquiry (IRCI) at ACU. From 2010 – 2015, she held the position of Associate Dean (Learning and Teaching) of the Faculty of Theology and Philosophy.

Formerly a teacher in Catholic primary and secondary schools and a liturgical musician and

composer, she has two main areas of theological research expertise. First, she investigates theological questions in ways that speak in and to the contemporary context, using hermeneutic phenomenology and poststructuralism. Second, she has expertise in the theology of recontextualisation and the promotion of the Catholic dialogue school. This is fundamental to her teaching and to the research translation she undertakes in consultancies around Australia.

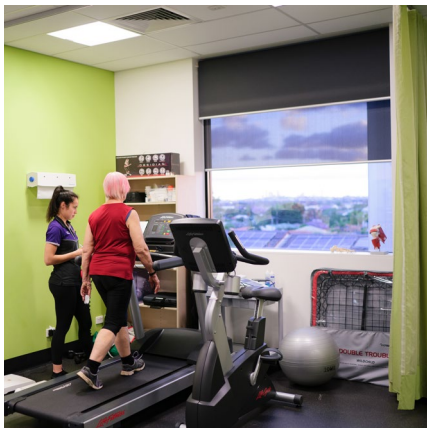

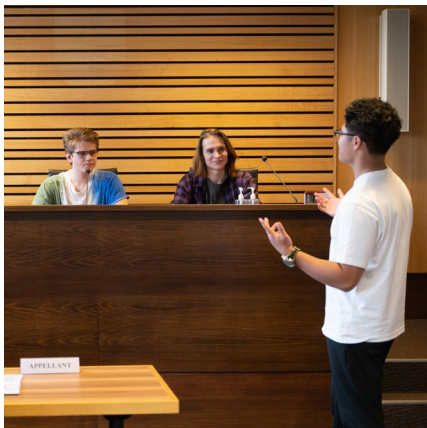

Postgraduate study

Postgraduate study generally falls into two main categories: coursework degrees and research degrees.



Coursework degrees

- Postgraduate coursework is ideal for gaining new skills and advancing your career.
- Programs can range from six months to two years full-time (or the part-time equivalent).
- Expect a mix of classes (including online classes), units and set assessments, much like an undergraduate degree.
- Generally, an undergraduate degree is required to apply; however, in some cases, professional experience will also be considered.
- The graduate certificate, graduate diploma and master's degree are interconnected and can be pursued progressively.
- If you're aiming for a master's degree but don't initially meet the entry requirements, you may be accepted into the graduate certificate or diploma in the same area of study.
- If you begin a master's degree but your circumstances change, you might be able to exit early with a graduate certificate or graduate diploma.

Recognition of prior learning

If you're studying a postgraduate coursework degree at another university and would like to switch to ACU, or you have relevant knowledge and skills acquired in the workplace, you may be able to get credit towards your degree.

VETERANS

Postgraduate research degrees

As a research candidate at ACU, you will join an active and engaged community dedicated to addressing today's critical global challenges. You'll learn and apply advanced research methodologies, tackle intellectual and practical problems, and build skills that expand your career and future opportunities.

- A research degree can open doors to a wide range of career paths both within and beyond academia.
- ACU research candidates have opportunities to collaborate with businesses, government, not-for-profits and community organisations to achieve innovative results with global impact.
- You will conduct independent research and explore original ideas under the guidance of a supervisory team.
- To apply, you must meet the eligibility criteria outlined in the Higher Degree Research policy at acu.edu.au/r/HDR-policy
- Master's programs are typically two years full-time while doctoral programs are typically three years full-time (or equivalent part-time).

Pathway to a research degree

Honours degrees are one-year degrees for high-achieving students who have already completed a bachelor's degree, allowing candidates to build upon their knowledge, develop research skills, and work closely with academic experts. The chief focus of the degree is to produce a research thesis under the supervision of an experienced academic. Some four-year bachelor's programs have honours programs embedded into their third and fourth years.

ALTERNATIVE PATHWAYS

There are various other pathway programs that provide the required research training to enable students who have not completed honours degrees or master's by research to qualify for admission into a Higher Degree Research program. Visit acu.edu.au/research-how-to-apply

Fees and Scholarships

There are plenty of options to help you manage the cost of study. Tuition fees depend on the course you enrol in. Postgraduate coursework students have two placement types: a fee-paying place or a Commonwealth supported place (CSP). CSPs are available for many of our coursework degrees, which makes it more affordable for you to study. For research degrees, scholarships are available to support domestic and international students, covering living expenses, tuition fees, health insurance and relocation costs.

COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED PLACE (CSP)

A wide range of postgraduate courses at ACU offer CSPs, where the government pays a proportion of tuition costs. The remaining fees are paid by the student, but eligible students can defer their payment through the HECS-HELP government loan scheme. Loan repayment occurs through the tax system once your income exceeds the minimum threshold. Domestic students who have received an offer to study a CSP-eligible postgraduate program are automatically considered before each semester starts.

RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS

We offer competitive stipend scholarships to domestic and international students to help fund your living costs during your research degree, and reward outstanding academic achievement. Scholarships are available to support Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander peoples to undertake a research doctorate or research master's degree. International students who apply for a stipend scholarship may be considered for an ACU Tuition Fee Scholarship and Overseas Student Healthcare Cover.

FEE-PAYING PLACE

A fee-paying place is not subsidised by the government, so you pay the full cost of the course. As a domestic fee-paying student, you may be eligible to defer payment of your fees through the FEE-HELP government loan scheme. Loan repayment occurs through the tax system once your income exceeds the minimum threshold. Your employer may also assist with the cost of study if the course is related to your current position.

Domestic students approved for enrolment in a master's by research or doctorate program at ACU receive a Research Training Program Fees Offset Scholarship. International students applying for admission to an ACU research degree may be considered for an ACU Tuition Fee Scholarship and Overseas Student Healthcare Cover.

ALLIED HEALTH

Family and systemic therapy

Family and systemic therapy helps practitioners support families and other interconnected groups by recognising and using their existing strengths and relationships. The goal is to ease distress and reduce the impact of difficult symptoms for the person who is struggling. These courses are appropriate for psychologists, clinical social workers and other professionals already working in family-sensitive programs. The key difference between systemic and family therapy and individual psychological interventions is that the former brings parts or all of the system – not just the individual – into the therapy.

Mental health

Our mental health programs are designed to expand health clinicians' knowledge and skills in mental health practice and leadership so that they can better understand and support the mental health challenges of their clients. These programs are designed for health professionals who have no formal mental health training, but who work with people facing mental health issues. They provide a shift in focus from acute inpatient treatment to that of recovery-orientated and trauma-informed care.

Social work

Social work focuses on improving individual and community wellbeing by addressing challenges such as inequality, discrimination, violence and other types of harassment. It equips graduates with a sound understanding of social work values and practice approaches through experiential learning and supervised field education and training.
