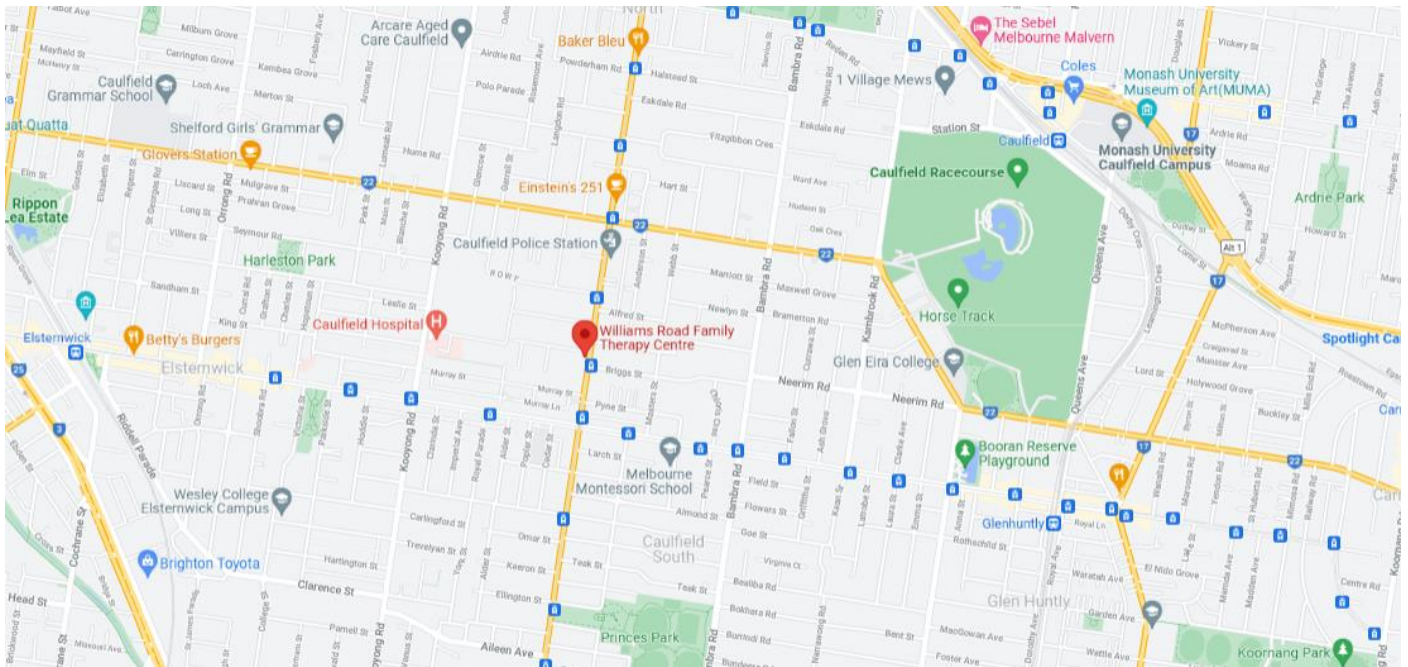

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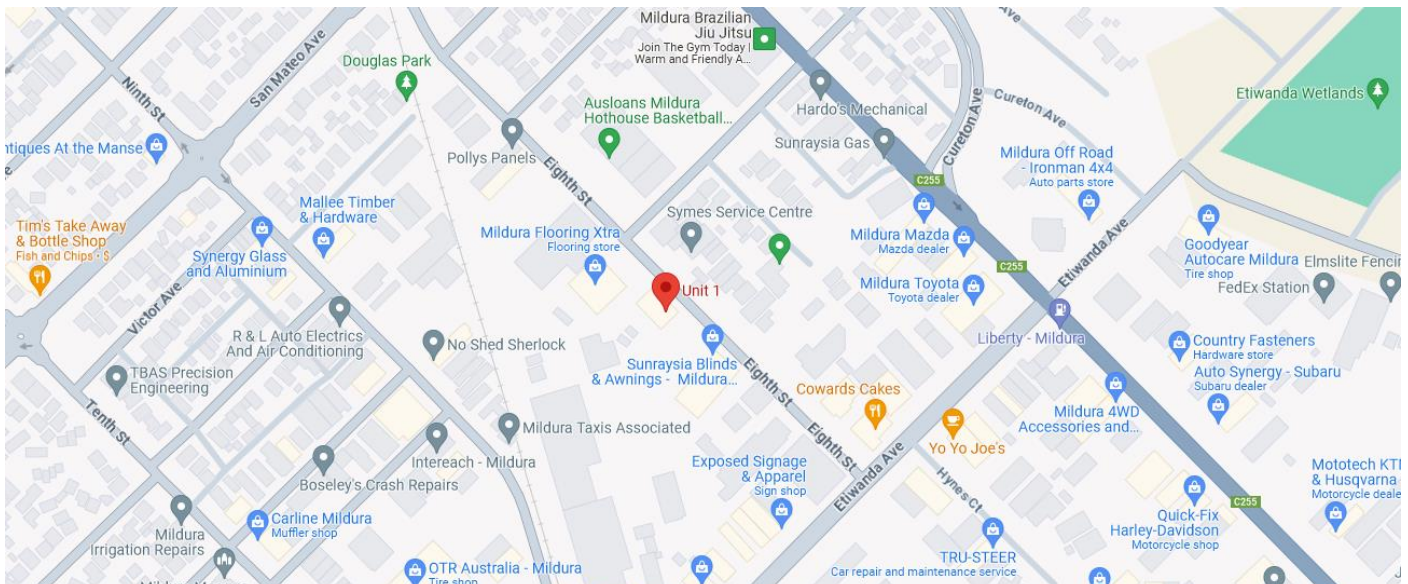
**Location Information**

## STUDY MODES

All units are delivered in Multi-mode.

### C - On Campus

Most learning activities or classes are delivered at a scheduled time, on campus, to enable in-person interactions. Activities will appear in a student's timetable.

### M - Multi-mode

Learning activities are delivered through a planned mix of online and in-person classes, which may include full-day sessions and/or placements, to enable interaction. Activities that require attendance will appear in a student's timetable.

### OU - Online unscheduled

Learning activities are accessible anytime, anywhere. These units are normally delivered fully online and will not appear in a student's timetable.

### OS – Online scheduled

All learning activities are held online at scheduled times and require virtual attendance at the scheduled time to enable online interaction. Activities will appear in a student's timetable.

- Prerequisites are other units that you must have passed *before* enrolling in the unit.
